

List of VICEROYS OF INDIA

When India and Pakistan became independent in 1947, the title of viceroy was taken off. The last governor general and first viceroy was Lord Canning. The last viceroy British India and the first governor general of free India was Lord Mountbatten. He retired in June 1948 and was succeeded by C. Rajagopalachari, who was the first and the last Indian Governor General of free India.
